

2017-2018 7th Grade Red Team Expectations

The 7th Grade Red team will be held to high standards. As teachers, these are our expectations, and as students they are to meet if not exceed them. We are a team, and the only way to succeed is to work together and hold one another accountable. These are our procedures and rules in every class.

1. Arrival to Class

- a. Bring all materials to every class (including agenda)
- b. Come into class quietly
- c. Write down your homework into your agenda (not just a piece of paper). This will be checked daily in advisory.
- d. Place agenda in upper right hand corner of your desk
- e. Get out your homework to be spot checked for completion or adhere to your teacher's policy.
- f. Begin working on your "warm up", "bell ringer", or "DGP"
- g. WE expect you to do these things daily without being told in each of your classes. (Consequence = detention for not following directions)

2. Morning Help

- a. Available every morning from 7:15 – 7:40 a.m.
- b. Bring all materials home with you that you would need in morning help (cannot go to locker until 7:40)
- c. Must have a teacher specific pass to get into the hallway (front of agenda)
- d. May not go to locker before the 7:40 bell
- e. Cannot leave morning help without permission from teacher

3. Moment of Silence/Announcements

- a. The moment of silence will be observed in each class.
- b. You are not to talk, ask questions, or be any type of distraction during the moment of silence or when anyone is providing announcements.

4. Tardy Sheet

- a. If you are late, sign the tardy sheet. You should not have to be told to do this. If you are not in your seat when the bell rings, YOU ARE TARDY!
- b. If the tardy bell has already rung, you cannot go back to the locker if you left items needed for class.
- c. If you need to leave the room, use your agenda. The teacher must sign the pass in the back of the agenda in the appropriate location before leaving and upon returning.
- d. You are to return to class quickly as possible.
- e. No passes out of the class unless it is an emergency.

5. Working on Another Teacher's Work/Cheating

- a. If you are caught working on another teacher's assignment during the wrong class, that work will be taken up and given directly to the teacher for whom you were completing the work.
- b. It is up to the teacher at that point to decide if you will or will not receive credit.
- c. If caught cheating (copying another student's work, cheating during the test), you and the other party involved will be referred to the administration immediately. Cheating will not be tolerated. (Consequence = Saturday School)
- d. Do not sign any other person's name but your own. Forgery is against the law and not tolerated here at OMMS. (Consequence = generally Saturday School)

6. Advisory

- a. Bring your agenda, remaining homework for that day, and a book to the class.
- b. You will be earning a grade for having your agenda completed and being on task throughout the entire period.
- c. This will not be a social time. It is an opportunity to ask for help, work on your assignments, and participate in designated activities.
- d. You are not to talk or be any type of distraction during the period.
- e. You will leave your backpacks in your locker and not bring to advisory.

7. Behavior for a Substitute

- a. You are to be on your best behavior when there is a substitute in any classroom.
- b. Poor conduct while having a sub will not be tolerated.
- c. Stay in your assigned seat, follow the directions to the work left for you, and again, be on your best behavior.
- d. If your name is left for any reason, you have earned a detention upon the teacher's arrival back to school. No questions.
- e. Depending on the behavior, you may also be referred to the administration office.

8. No Gum/Cell Phones

- a. Enough said. No gum at school. If you choose to put a piece in your mouth, then you choose to earn a detention. Even if it is 3:01 or even 7:15, if you are in this school, do not chew gum!
- b. Cell phones and electronic personal media devices (discuss technology policy) are to remain in the off position in your locker throughout the school day.

9. Dress Code: Dress for Success

- a. Wear a belt with pants, skirts, and shorts at your waist, and have the appropriate length shorts, skirts, and dresses.
- b. Dress code will be checked during first period after announcements, before lunch, and periodically throughout the day.
- c. If you have been asked to be in dress code, and you are seen at a later point in the day out of dress code, you will be written up. Stay in dress code.
- d. Ladies, non-revealing necklines means just that. If you are asked to pull up your cami; for example, most likely you do not need to wear that shirt or cami.
- e. We will enforce dress code! (Consequence = detention)

10. E.A.E.T

- a. Do not get them! We expect for you to do your work on time and be responsible to have it in class.
- b. We understand that there are occasions when something may just not be going right that day; however, learn from your mistakes as well as those of your classmates.

11. Wiper/Sweeper

- a. Lunch manners: Clean up after yourself! Do not make someone else clean your mess.
- b. If is a dirty job, and you have to do it...sooner or later.
- c. If you are called back to the lunchroom to clean your table a second time, you will earn a 2nd week of being the wiper/sweeper.

12. Manners

- a. Bathroom Etiquette
- b. Wash hands.
- c. Sneeze into elbow (if you Kleenex, then germex).
- d. Always use your manners and respond when someone speaks to you in the appropriate manner ("yes ma'am", "no sir")
- e. No harassing/bullying.
- f. If it is not yours, then do not touch it.
- g. Do not say hateful things then just to follow with "I'm just kidding," or "Sorry"
- h. Think before speaking and/or acting.
- i. Listen the first time, and act appropriately.

13. REVIEW TECHNOLOGY POLICY

- a. No cell phones are permitted in PE, locker rooms, or restrooms.
- b. Adhere to all SCBOE and OMMS personally owned technology policies.

14. Safety! Walk in the hallways...get to where you are going quickly if you are running behind.

- a. Only bring required/necessary materials to school. No contraband (drugs, alcohol, weapons, inappropriate items).
- b. Fire Drill – quickly/quietly get out of the building with your class. Teacher will take roll.
- c. Tornado Drill - quickly/quietly get out of the classroom into the hallway with your class.
- d. Lockdown Drill - quickly/quietly into the safest place away from doors/windows in the classroom with your class.
 - i. (Classroom – lights out, windows covered, door locked for all drills)
