

- 1. a radical Russian Communist group that seized power in 1917
- 3. a form of the Greek alphabet
- 10. leader of the Bolsheviks; first leader of the Soviet Union
- 11. the government owns all the property and controls all aspects of life
- 14. fierce Mongol invaders from Central Asia who conquered Kiev in the 1200s
- Russian czar who modernized (or Westernized) the country; built a navy; acquired access to a warm water port; and built a new capital on the banks of the Neva River called St. Petersburg
- 19. overthrow (and execution) of Czar Nicholas II by the Bolsheviks in 1917

## Down

- also known as the Union of Socialist Soviet Republics (USSR); created by the communists after the Russian Revolution
- 3. a Russian emperor
- 4. Iv an IV, cruel ruler of Russia during the 1500s; first to call himself czar
- 5. farm laborers who were bought and sold with the land
- 6. Russia's most famous composer, his works include The Nutcracker and the 1812 Overture
- 7. a soviet labor camp
- 8. vast, grassy plains in southern Russia
- 9. the period, after World War II, of tense rivalry between the Soviet Union and the United States
- has been either president or prime minister of Russia since 1999. He has undertaken several aggressive actions as Russia's leader. Most notably in Chechnya (1999), Georgia (2008) and Ukraine (2014)
- 11. Empress of Russia for 34 years (1762-1796); favored reform, especially in education and the arts
- 12. Soviet leader who began to make changes, less governmental control and more democracy
- 13. a forest of mainly evergreen trees covering much of Russia
- 15. Known as the Czar-Liberator, freed the serfs from being tied to the land
- 16. brutal and paranoid dictator of the Soviet Union; took over after Lenin's death in 1924
- 17. the first artificial satellite in space (1957); started the "Space Race"
