## **Discussion questions:**

- 1. Why was Odysseus originally called away from home?
- 2. Why do you think he was willing to take on this challenge despite the risks involved?
- 3. What are three words you would use to describe Odysseus?
- 4. How does he compare with other "heroes" in literature?
- 5. Do you think he meets the definition of a hero? Discuss.
- 6. At several points in the epic, Odysseus' men let their guards down and pay a steep price. What is an example of this, and what are the lessons you could take away from this tale?
- 7. Who were the Lotus Eaters and how did they affect Odysseus' men?
- 8. What was the result of the Lotus Eaters interactions, and what lessons could you take away from this story?
- 9. How did Odysseus and his men end up in a confrontation with the one-eyed Cyclops?
- 10. What do you think were the most important decisions they made in order to survive their experience with the Cyclops?
- 11. Why do you think Penelope remained loyal to Odysseus even though she did not know when he would return?
- 12. What were some of the things Penelope did to trick her suitors?
- 13. Throughout *The Odyssey*, the hero and his men face many temptations. What is an example of one of these temptations, and how did it affect the men on their journey?
- 14. Based on the analysis in this program, where do historians think "Ithaca" might have been located? What are your thoughts about this reasoning?
- 15. What do you think were the three most important decisions made by Odysseus in the epic? How did these decisions help him survive?
- 16. Why do you think *The Odyssey* is still considered one of the world's finest works of literature?
