OMIS CAR RIDER GUIDELINES AND SAFETY

Welcome back for another great year at OMIS! Your child's PE teachers also take care of dismissal for all car riders each and every day. For your child's safety, we ask that you read the following guidelines that will be in effect each afternoon.

- 1. Students will exit the building at the 2:55 bell and be seated on the sidewalk facing the cars. They will sit on the sidewalk between the front door and Blue Hall. It is the responsibility of each student to watch for his/her car.
- 2. If a student sees his/her parent in the group of cars between the 2 crosswalks they may stand up on the sidewalk and wait until the P. E. teachers blow the whistle which is the signal for students to proceed to the cars. Once the whistle is blown, the child may walk to his/her car.
- 3. Once the P.E teachers see that all cars have been loaded, they will motion drivers to proceed forward; please do not begin to move until we have waved you forward; this is due to the possibility that some students are still moving between vehicles; please try to avoid rolling forward while waiting for us to wave the group forward.
- 4. The P.E. teachers will then motion for the next group of cars to pull forward. **Please** pull forward until the P.E. teachers tell you to stop! **Please** pull up to the car in front of you leaving enough space for someone to walk through.
- 5. For the safety of all students please try to avoid cell phone use while in line; their safety takes precedence over everything else.
- 6. Students know to wait for our whistle to begin loading; please do not call out to them, or try to get them to load until that signal has been given.

These Rules and Guidelines are to help each child get to his/her ride safely and securely!
