The Every Student Succeeds Act (ESSA) is a federal law that requires states to assess all students. Remote students may not opt-out of testing. To ensure that our remote and traditional students are tested at school and safety protocols are in place, we have created a schedule that incorporates e-days to complete testing for middle school students. Traditional students will have an e-day on the dates listed below. Remote students should report to their home school at 8:00 on the dates listed below.

Only remote students will report to school on these days. Traditional students will work remotely.

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If your child will be taking the ACAP Alternate Assessment, you will be notified by your child's teacher of the day and time for testing if you are a remote student.
