DYSLEXIA DEFINED

DYSLEXIA IS A COMMOM CONDITION THAT AFFECTS THE WAY THE BRAIN PROCESSES LANGUAGE. DYSLEXIA MAKES IT DIFFICULT FOR STUDENTS TO READ AND SPELL, BUT IS NOT A SIGN OF LOW INTELLIGENCE. THE ALABAMA STATE DEPT OF EDUCATION DEFINES DYSLEXIA AS A "LEARNING CHALLENGE THAT IS NEUROLOGICAL IN ORIGIN AND CHARACTERIZED BY DIFFICULTIES WITH ACCURATE AND/OR FLUENT WORD RECOGNITION AND BY POOR SPELLING AND DECODING ABILITIES."





DYSLEXIA SUPPORT

ALABAMA IS MAKING STRIDES IN ADDRESSING THE NEEDS OF DYSLEXIC STUDENTS AND SHELBY COUNTY SCHOOLS IS FOLLOWING SUIT. WHILE WE CAN'T DIAGNOSE DYSLEXIA WITHIN THE SCHOOL SYSTEM, WE CAN SCREEN FOR IT. IF A STUDENT FAILS THE DYSLEXIA SCREENER THEY WILL BEGIN TO RECEIVE INTERVENTION AND BE MONITORED THROUGH THE PROBLEM SOLVING TEAM AT EACH SCHOOL. SCS HAS DYSLEXIA SUPPORT SERVICES READILY AVAILABLE TO TEACHERS, PARENTS, AND STUDENTS. TALKING ABOUT DYSLEXIA

AN IMPORTANT PART OF DYSLEXIA AWARENESS MONTH, IS EDUCATING THOSE AROUND US. ACCORDING TO THE INTERNATIONAL DYSLEXIA ASSOCIATION, AS MANY AS 15-20% OF THE POPULATION, SHOW SYMPTOMS OF DYSLEXIA. DYSLEXIA OCCURS IN PEOPLE OF ALL BACKGROUNDS AND INTELLECTUAL LEVELS. DID YOU KNOW THAT DYSLEXIA RUNS IN FAMILIES? PARENTS WITH DYSLEXIA ARE LIKELY TO HAVE CHILDREN WITH DYSLEXIA. BECAUSE THIS LEARNING DIFFERENCE AFFECTS SO MANY, IT IS TIME TO TALK ABOUT IT, LEARN ABOUT IT, AND DO OUR PART TO BE A VOICE FOR THE DYSLEXIC PEOPLE IN OUR LIVES.

WHILE DYSLEXIA BRINGS CHALLENGES IN THE AREAS OF READING AND WRITING, PEOPLE WITH DYSLEXIA ARE OFTEN GIFTED IN AREAS SUCH AS ART, COMPUTER SCIENCE, DESIGN, DRAMA, ELECTRONICS, MATH, MECHANICS, MUSIC, PHYSICS, SALES, AND SPORTS. IT IS ESPECIALLY IMPORTANT THAT WE TAKE NOTE OF THE GIFTS THAT DYSLEXIC STUDENTS HAVE TO OFFER AND WORK TO ACCOMMODATE IN THE AREAS THAT THEY NEED SUPPORT.
