- PRESIDENTIAL HONORS SCHOLARSHIP. Students are required to have a minimum 3.5 GPA with a minimum 24 ACT score. Recipients will be required to enroll in an academic degree-seeking program of study and maintain full-time status with a cumulative 3.0 GPA. This scholarship will cover in-state tuition and fees up to \$4,800 per academic year, not to exceed two years, or completion of program of study, whichever occurs first. This scholarship does not cover remedial coursework.
- ACADEMIC EXCELLENCE SCHOLARSHIP. Students are required to have a minimum 3.25 GPA with a minimum 20 ACT score. Selected recipients are required to enroll in an academic degree-seeking program of study and must maintain full-time status with a cumulative 3.0 GPA. This scholarship will cover in-state tuition and fees up to \$3,600 per academic year, not to exceed two years, or completion of program of study, whichever occurs first. This scholarship does not cover remedial coursework.
- PERFORMING ARTS SCHOLARSHIP. Students are required to have a minimum 2.50 GPA. Applicants will be contacted by the performing arts faculty to arrange an audition. Auditions may be conducted throughout the year based on the program needs. Selected recipients must maintain full-time status and a cumulative 2.5 GPA. This scholarship covers in-state tuition and fees up to \$3,000 per academic year, not to exceed two years or completion of the program of study, whichever occurs first. This scholarship does not cover remedial coursework. Please place a check () by one of the following PERFORMING ARTS SCHOLARSHIP concentrations listed below.

- CAREER TECHNICAL HONORS SCHOLARSHIP. Students are required to have a minimum 2.50 GPA. Applicants must declare a career/technical program. Selected recipients must maintain full-time status and a cumulative 2.5 GPA. This scholarship covers in-state tuition and fees up to \$4,500 per academic year, not to exceed two years, or completion of program of study, whichever occurs first. This scholarship does not cover remedial coursework.

- (6) For students graduating prior to 2018, you MUST provide an unofficial transcript for ALL colleges attended and an unofficial copy of your high school transcript. Note: official transcripts showing a graduation date are required by the Office of Enrollment Services prior to enrollment at CACC.
- (7) I understand that failure to meet the GPA requirements and/or failure to provide ALL required documentation will result in my Scholarship Application Packet being marked INELIGIBLE.. I understand that it is my responsibility to verify that my application packet is complete. Due to the large number of applicants, students WILL NOT be notified of incomplete packets prior to the application deadline.
- (8) I understand that scholarships are awarded on a competitive basis, and meeting minimum eligibility requirements will not guarantee applicants will be awarded a scholarship.
