Kiwanis/Key Club Scholarship Guidelines

- 1. Read the application and instructions **BEFORE** you complete each section.
- 2. Edit Footer by replacing APPLICANT NAME with your name. You must attach:
 - a. General Application form
 - b. one (1) sheet for your Key Club activities signed by sponsor
 - c. one (1) sheet for your religious, volunteer, and community activities signed by sponsor, minister, or community supervisor who observed activities
 - d. one (1) sheet for your essay
 - e. two reference letters (no more than 2 pages in length for each letter)
 - f. official high school transcript for freshman year through the first semester of senior year
- 3. Please omit the Guidelines and Scoring Matrix pages when printing your Application. These pages are for your information.
- 4. When preparing your sheets about activities, list in chronological order including the estimated number of hours you spent each year on the activity.
- 5. Applicant should submit 4 copies of the complete application packet in separate sealed 9x12 envelopes. Applicant should put their name on a small label in the lower left corner so that the Scholarship Committee can use address labels to deliver to the judges if necessary. Application packets must be received by the Key Club Sponsor or School Counselor by 3:15 PM on April 27, 2018.
- 6. Scholarship Eligibility:
 - a. Applicant should submit complete (see #2 above) and typewritten or computer printed Application Package by the deadline. Completeness and whether directions were followed will be considered in scoring.
 - b. Applicant must be a SCHS Key Club member in good standing (has paid Dues and appears on Official Membership Roster).
 - c. Applicant must be a graduating senior who is planning to attend an institution of higher education, i.e., community college, four-year college, university, technical school, or vocational college.

7. Selection Process:

- a. The Scholarship Committee of the Kiwanis Club of Columbiana will select Judges, who shall remain anonymous.
- b. The Key Club Sponsor will forward the sealed application packets to the Scholarship Committee who will distribute to the Judges.
- c. The Judges will return their score sheets to the Scholarship committee, who will then tally the scores. The scores will be kept confidential.
- 8. The Kiwanis Club of Columbiana will present a Certificate to the recipient during the Awards program prior to graduation.
- 9. Funds will be disbursed directly to the educational institution or to the recipient upon receiving receipts for registration fees, books, or other expenses directly related to the educational experience.
