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## FAQ's

Q: How much is the fee this year?

A: It's \$35

Q: What time to the sessions start?

A: We plan on offering several choices this year: 3:45, 4:30, 5:30 and 6:00. If needed, we will consider adding more.

Q: Can I sign up for more than one session?

A: Yes, if your schedule allows you can do 2 sessions in an evening. The more popular sessions will be offered again if needed, at a different time slot than originally offered.

Q: Who should I make the check out to?

A: Boy Scouts of America or BSA

Q: What if I can't make the kick off meeting?

A: You can still participate, but you will need to turn in your registration paperwork and fee prior to the first meeting.

Q: Do I have to sign up ahead of time?

A: Yes

Q: Why do I have to sign up ahead of time?
