2018 – 2019 AMBASSADOR SCHOLARSHIP APPLICATION

The Central Alabama Community College Ambassador Organization is a distinguished group of students selected to serve as representatives for the College on campus and in the community. Applicants are evaluated on the completed scholarship application, evidence of leadership potential, school/civic/community engagement, and interviews.

Students are required to have a minimum 3.0 cumulative GPA with a minimum ACT score of 20. This scholarship covers in-state tuition and fees up to \$4,800 per academic year, not to exceed two years, or completion of program of study, whichever occurs first. This scholarship does not cover remedial coursework.

- _____ (5) For students graduating prior to 2018, you MUST provide an unofficial transcript for ALL colleges attended and an unofficial copy of your high school transcript. Note: official transcripts showing a graduation date are required by the Office of Enrollment Services prior to enrollment at CACC.
- _____ (6) I understand that failure to meet the GPA requirements and/or failure to provide ALL required documentation will result in my Scholarship Application Packet being marked INELIGIBLE, and I will not be considered for a scholarship. I understand that it is my responsibility to verify that my application packet is complete. Due to the large number of applicants, students WILL NOT be notified of incomplete packets prior to the application deadline.
- _____ (7) I understand that scholarships are awarded on a competitive basis, and meeting minimum eligibility requirements will not guarantee applicants will be awarded a scholarship.
- _____ (8) Notification will be made by mail. No results will be provided by email or telephone.
