

# APPRENTICESHIPS GET RESULTS

Three Registered Apprenticeships have been developed in partnership with The Alabama Office of Apprenticeship, local community colleges and employers in the Birmingham Region:

- Machine Tool Technology
- Welding Technology
- Industrial Maintenance

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## A PROVEN MODEL

A survey of business with apprenticeship programs found that **97%** would recommend apprenticeships to others.

## HIGHER RETENTION

**91%** of apprentices stay with their employer after their formal training ends.

## INCREASED PRODUCTIVITY

Studies have found that the productivity of apprentices compared to skilled workers increased from 37% in the first year of training to **75%** by the end of a three-year program.

## RETURN ON INVESTMENT

The return on investment for a registered apprenticeship program is **\$1.46** for every \$1 invested in an apprentice.
