

Shelby County NAACP Unit 50AB Scholarship Award

The Shelby County chapter of the NAACP, in partnership with the Montevallo Legacy Project, is proud to announce our annual scholarship program dedicated to empowering future leaders of our community. This scholarship opportunity is open to graduating high school seniors in Shelby County public schools who have demonstrated a commitment to advancing racial justice and the potential to be outstanding community leaders.

Eligibility Criteria:

- Graduating high school senior in a public school in Shelby County, AL
- Active involvement in community service or extracurricular activities
- Demonstrated leadership skills and commitment to social justice and equality.
- Plan to attend an accredited college/university for the 2024-2025 academic year OR to attend a trade school for certification in one of the trades (electricians, plumbers, stylists, truckers, etc.) for the 2024-2025 year.

Scholarship Details:

- Awards totaling \$5000 will be distributed in amounts to be determined by the Scholarship Committee's evaluation of the applications submitted. In the past, awards were \$2500, \$1500, and \$1000.
- Application deadline: Sunday, February 25, 2024 @ 11:59 pm
- Award Announcement Date: Sunday, March 24, 2024

Use of scholarship: To be applied toward tuition and other costs associated with the first year of post-secondary study.

Selection Process: A panel of judges will assess applications based on community involvement, potential for community leadership, and the alignment of applicants' values with the NAACP mission.

II. Proof of GPA Submit high school transcript (official or unofficial). All GPAs considered.

III. 500-word essay, typewritten and double-spaced:

Write on *one* of the following:

- 1) Describe an event or experience that impacted your understanding of racial or economic injustice. How did it change you?
- 2) "Education is the most powerful weapon which you can use to change the world." -- Nelson Mandela. How would you use your education to make the world a better place for persons of color of your generation?

Requirements:

- Times New Roman 12 point
- Double-space
- MLA format
- Outside sources must be cited

Evaluation criteria:

Strong essays will express a thoughtful personal response to the topic and will align with the values of the NAACP mission. They will use telling details and specifics. They will be written in your voice, reflect your lived experience, and suggest why you are a good candidate to receive an NAACP scholarship award.

Proofread carefully. Surface errors, misspellings, misleading word choices, and carelessly constructed sentences may give the impression that you lack the commitment to be an effective community leader.

Essays developed by chatGPT will not be considered.

IV. Two letters of recommendation.

Use the form provided below to secure two letters of recommendation. They may be written by teachers, school administrators, school counselors, employers, community leaders and/or pastors.

NOTE: Letters must be emailed directly by the recommender to *naacp@gmail.com*. They should be received by the February 25, 2024, deadline.

V. Verification of community service.

Use the form provided below to verify community service.

Submission of application materials.

Submit all materials except letters of recommendation to *naacpshelby@gmail.com* by February 25, 2024. PDFs preferred. Be sure that your application package includes *all* the following:

- Application form
- Proof of GPA
- Essay
- Verification of community service

Letters of recommendation should be sent separately by two recommenders to *naacpshelby@gmail.com* by February 15, 2024.

What's next?

A panel of judges selected by the Shelby County branch of the NAACP will review all *completed* application materials. They will select award recipients based on community involvement, potential for community leadership, and alignment with the values of the NAACP mission.

Awards will be announced by March 24, 2024.
