

Math Tip Worksheet

Knowing how to calculate a tip at a restaurant quickly and precisely is a good skill to have. It is acceptable to tip between 15 and 20 percent of your total bill. Use these examples to sharpen your tipping skills!



1. At Pizza Hut, your bill was \$15.97. *You tip 15%. What is the final cost of your bill?*

2. Your lunch bill came to \$9.87. *You tip 20%. What is the final cost of your bill?*

3. You and a friend ordered fajitas for two, and agreed to split the bill. The bill came to \$19.06. *You + your friend tip 18%. Calculate your final cost then determine how much each of you should pay.*

4. You went to a coffeehouse with friends and ordered an iced coffee and desert, which came to \$6.87. *You tip 18%. What is the final cost of your bill?*

5. At dinner, your waiter got your orders mixed up and then failed to refill your drink. The bill came to \$21.99. *You tip 10%. What is the final cost of your bill?*
