- 2) A pizza chain uses 504 grams of cheese on their pizzas. If they sold 92 pizzas, how many grams would they have used?
- 3) A farmer has 309 rows of corn. If he can get 33 ears of corn from each row, how many ears of corn would he have total?
- 4) A cruise ship compartment can hold 779 pieces of luggage. If a ship had 53 compartments, how many pieces of luggage can it hold?
- 5) There are 730 hotels in a hotel chain. If each hotel has 18 rooms, how many rooms are there total?
- 6) A coat manufacturer puts 862 coats in a shipment. If they sent out 85 shipments, how many coats would they have sent out?
- 7) A candy store had 833 empty shelves. If each shelf can hold 46 pieces of candy, how many pieces would they need total to fill up all the shelves?
- 8) A lawn mowing company had 837 customers. If each customer paid 29 dollars a year, how much money would they make?
- 9) A school bought 477 boxes of computer paper for the computer lab. Each box had 23 sheets of paper inside it. How much paper did they buy total?
- 10) A marathon was 340 meters. If 38 people ran in the marathon how many meters would they have run total?
