<p>1. Mean</p>	<p>the sum of the numbers in a set of data divided by the number of pieces of data; it is also referred to as the "average"</p>	<p>$6 + 6 + 9 + 11 = 32 \div 4 = 8$</p>	<p>$486 + 494 + 502 + 690 = 2172 \div 4 =$</p>
<p>2. Median</p>	<p>the middle number in a set of data once the data has been arranged in numerical order; it is also referred to as the "middle"</p>	<p>34 36 42 44 28 30</p>	<p>23 17 20 21 23 $37 \div 2 = 18.5$</p>
<p>3. Mode</p>	<p>the number/numbers that appear most often in a set of data; there can be more than one mode</p>	<p>6, 9, 11</p>	<p>12, 2, 3, 4, 5, 7, 9</p>
<p>4. Range</p>	<p>the difference between the greatest number and the least number in a set of data</p>	<p>12 16 18 18 25 28 30 13 34 36 42 44 44 - 12 = 32</p>	<p>21 23 23 - 13 = 10</p>
